USAID's MEASURE Evaluation Project and Addis Continental Institute of Public Health, Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, are pleased to announce a training opportunity for the Anglophone Africa region. Addis Continental Institute of Public Health will be offering the "Regional Workshop on Monitoring and Evaluation of HIV/AIDS Programs." This two-week course will take place May 6-17, 2013, and will be taught in English.

The MEASURE Evaluation Project is committed to capacity building in monitoring and evaluation. As a part of this commitment, we have been collaborating with regional institutions to provide training opportunities to meet the need for monitoring and evaluation skills among professionals working in HIV/AIDS programs. The course given by Addis Continental Institute of Public Health will accomplish this by providing intensive training that will cover the fundamentals of strong monitoring and evaluation of HIV/AIDS programs:

- Program Design Frameworks
- Indicator Development
- Performance Monitoring and Evaluation Plans
- HIV Information Sources and Systems
- Tools and techniques specific to monitoring HIV/AIDS specialized interventions including: prevention; care and treatment; orphans and vulnerable children (OVC) Lot Quality Assurance Surveys (LQAS); and estimating the size of key populations
- Facilitating Use of Strategic Information

MEASURE Evaluation staff will join faculty from Addis Continental Institute of Public Health to provide instruction. The course will target mid-level health and population officers, program managers and other professionals involved with the implementation of HIV/AIDS programs.

The fee for the course is US \$2,500. This tuition fee *does not* include airfare, lodging, visa fees, evening meals or other incidental expenses. A limited number of MEASURE Evaluation fellowships are available for well-qualified applicants who are citizens of USAID priority countries. **Please note that the application deadline is March 15, 2013.**
