Some things to note:

- In one migrant household, the study migrant was interviewed (**IVSTATUS=1**), while in the second household the study migrant was noted to be interviewed in another migrant household (**IVSTATUS=2**).
- The 1994 household identifiers are identical across the migrant households.
- The age, **Q8_2**, of the individuals are not always the same across the households. In fact, for the returned home migrant (**MID=2024011**), Form 8 was not even administered, so age could not be verified in that manner.

Some things to note:

- For the first two examples, in one migrant household the study migrant was interviewed (**IVSTATUS=1**), while in the second household the study migrant was noted to be interviewed in another migrant household (**IVSTATUS=2**). For the third example, the migrant is interviewed as a study migrant in one household, but is not listed as a study migrant in the second household.
- The 2000 household identifiers are identical across the migrant households.
- The age, **Q8_2**, of the individuals are not always the same across the households.
