

Examples of “Code 5 Individuals” in the 1994 Survey Data

One Code 5 Individual in the 1994 Survey on Two Household Rosters

Below is an example of a code 5 individual in 1994 (highlighted in yellow), who is listed on two different household rosters – an origin household and a destination household. This particular individual was interviewed in a new household in the village:

Some things to note:

1. In the origin household, the code 5 individual is always listed on Form 1 (**FORM=1**) and coded as '5' on the **Q1** variable. Further, the origin household is always an old household (**HHTYPE94=1**). In the destination household, the code 5 individual is either **Q1=1** (moved to a new household) or **Q1=4** (moved into another old household and listed on Form 2).
2. The tracking variables in the origin household show that this person was verified (**CODE2=5**) to be living in a destination household (**DHHID94=20040662** & **DCEP94=501**).
3. The variables, **MIPRO** and **MIDIS**, in the origin household show the original migrant destination reported by the household.
4. The code 5 individual's 1984 and 2000 identifiers are exactly the same in the origin and destination households.
