

Special Call for Applications to the Carolina Population Center Postdoctoral Training Program
Applications must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. (EDT) on Friday, August 12, 2016. The selected candidate(s)
must be available to begin the appointment NO LATER than October 1, 2016.
Electronic submission is required.

The Carolina Population Center requests applications for the AY 2016-17 postdoctoral scholar training program; successful candidates must be available to begin the position(s) no later than **October 1, 2016**. The position(s) are supported by the National Institutes of Health; funding restrictions require the postdoctoral scholar to be a US citizen or Legal Permanent Resident.

A key consideration in the selection of the postdoctoral scholar is the congruence of research interests between applicant and faculty preceptor. Applicants must contact potential CPC faculty preceptor(s) as soon as possible to arrange sponsorship. Applicants should consult the list of CPC [Faculty Fellows](https://www.cpc.unc.edu/people/fellows) (<https://www.cpc.unc.edu/people/fellows>), and contact potential sponsors to determine their availability and interest. The initial term of appointment is one year, but reappointment for a second (final year) is expected.

 - o Research and career plans following postdoctoral training (1 page)
5. Copies of any research publications in population or related areas (*no more than 3*) (**lastname_WS1.pdf; lastname_WS2.pdf; lastname_WS3.pdf**).
6. A document with the following information (**lastname_OTH.pdf**):
 - o Citizenship/Residency status, and
 - o Address, phone number, and email as of **August 1, 2016**.

1. Three letters of recommendation sent by the writers directly to Jan Hendrickson-Smith, CPC Associate Director of Training Programs (address listed below; email preferred). **DUE NO LATER THAN August 12, 2016.**
2. A letter of endorsement for the application and proposed training program by one or more CPC Faculty Fellows who agree to serve as preceptor(s) - sent by the writers directly to Jan Hendrickson-Smith, CPC Associate Director of Training Programs (address listed below; email preferred). **DUE NO LATER THAN August 12, 2016.**
