Project Description

The Family Matters Project is an NIH-funded study of pregnant people's family networks and how the social support and conflict within them are related to maternal health during pregnancy. Survey and semi-structured data collection will be ongoing this summer.

Scope of Work for Internship

The summer intern for this project would help with a variety of tasks. There may be administrative work to help keep track of how many interviews have been completed and the demographic characteristics of respondents. The intern would also help with the cleaning, coding, and analysis of qualitative data coming in from the interviews. This work will be done in Dedoose, an online qualitative analysis software.

Expected Deliverables

Cleaning of 40 interview transcripts that have been auto-transcribed
Organization of transcripts in Dedoose with topic coding completed for all 40 interviews
1-10 page literature review on a previously agreed upon topic
