Project Description

The Family Matters Project is an NIH-funded study of how one's family network can have positive or negative effects on health during pregnancy. We are conducting 425 survey and 50 open-ended interviews to result in quantitative and qualitative data for analysis.

Scope of Work for Internship

Conducting literature reviews, facilitating auto-transcription of interview recordings, checking and cleaning interview transcripts, reading transcripts and providing summary memos, participating in team meetings to develop and revise codebooks, coding transcripts in Dedoose, and helping to draft article manuscripts.

Expected Deliverables

Cleaned transcripts, coding in Dedoose, summary memos, powerpoint presentation, and possibly sections of an article manuscript.
